**ACADEMIC YEAR-2022-23**

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## **GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION IN EMRS, KSP & MRS**

In supersession of all the guidelines in governing admissions in EMRS, KSP & MRS that have been issued in the past by any of the Authority, the following guidelines are issued to uniformly regulate admissions in the EMRS, KSP & MRS with effect from the academic session 2022-23 & onwards.

### **PART – 1 DEFINITION**

Unless the context suggests otherwise, the definition of the following terms used in these guidelines would be as below: -

- 1.1 **“MoTA”** refers to Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.
- 1.2 **“NESTS”** means the National Education Society for Tribal Students.
- 1.3 **“MPSARAS”** means Madhya Pradesh Special and Residential Academic Society.
- 1.4 **“EMRS”** means Eklavya MRS.
- 1.5 **“KSP”** means Kanya Shiksha parisar.
- 1.6 **“MRS”** means Model Residential School.
- 1.7 **“MPTAASC”** means Madhya Pradesh Tribal Affairs & Scheduled Caste Welfare Automation System.
- 1.8 **“Academic year”** means a period of 12 months beginning from the 1st of April to 31st March of the succeeding year.
- 1.9 **“MPSRSST”** means Madhya Pradesh Special & Residential Schools Selection Test.
- 1.10 **“MPSRSLT”** means Madhya Pradesh Special & Residential Schools Lateral Entry Test.
- 1.11 **“ST”** means Scheduled Tribes.
- 1.12 **“PVTG”** means Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group (Baiga, Bharia and Sahariya).
- 1.13 **“DNT”** means De-notified Tribes.
- 1.14 **“NT”** means Nomadic Tribes.
- 1.15 **“SNT”** means Semi-Nomadic Tribes.

1.16 **“LWE”** refers to the loss of parents in Left Wing Extremism being either as a soldier or a victim.

1.17 **“Person with disability”** means a person suffering from not less than forty percent of any disability as certified by a medical authority.

1.18 **“Blindness”** refers to a condition where a person suffers from any of the following conditions namely: -

- Total absence of sight; or
- Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses; or
- Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degree or worse.

1.19 **“Hearing Impairment”** means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies.

1.20 **“Locomotor disability”** means disability of the bones joints or muscles leading to Substantial restriction of the movement of the limbs or any form of cerebral palsy.

## **PART – 2 GENERAL GUIDELINES**

### **2.1. Admission Eligibility:**

The minimum and maximum age limit (as on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the year in which admission is sought) for admission in EMRS, KSP & MRS in various classes is given below: **(Child born on 1st April should also be considered.)**

<b>VI</b>	10 years	13 years
<b>VII</b>	11 years	14 years
<b>VIII</b>	12 years	15 years
<b>IX</b>	13 years	16 years
<b>X</b>	14 years	17 years

#### **Note:**

1. The maximum age limit is relaxed by two years in case of Differently abled children.
2. There is no age restriction for admission to Class XI provided the student is seeking admission in the year of passing Class X examination. Similarly, there will be no upper & lower age limit for admission to class XII provided there has been no break in the continuous study of the student after passing class XI.

### **ADMISSION FOR CLASS VI:**

- Candidate should be of age group 10 to 13 years (Applicable to all categories).
- Candidate should have qualified class V from a Govt. / Govt. aided/ Govt. recognized School/ CBSE Affiliated School/ Level B of NIOS OBE Programme. Or a Candidate who has not attended any school but studied at home is also eligible to apply for admission in Class VI (As per section 4 of Chapter II of RTE Act 2009). However, the parents/ guardian of the candidate have to submit a self-declaration regarding the same.

- Candidate should not be rusticated from any of the schools.

**General Eligibility Criteria:**

- I. The candidates should have Madhya Pradesh domicile and should belong to the reservation categories mentioned at table 2.3.
- II. A candidate should fulfill the age criteria as mentioned in the admission guidelines. In case of doubtful cases of overage in comparison to the age recorded in the certificate, they may be referred to the State/District Medical Board for confirmation of the age. The decision of the Medical Board will be treated as final and binding on both the parties.
- III. A candidate appearing for the MPSRSST for admission in Class VI for the Session **2022-23** should be studying or has studied in Class-V in the Academic Session **2021-22 or 2020- 21** in a Government/ Government aided/ State recognized schools/ Level B of NIOS OBE Programme/ CBSE Affiliated Schools of the State where he/she is seeking admission (in EMRS, KSP & MRS). A school will be deemed recognized if it is declared so by the Government or by any other agency authorized on behalf of Government.

or

A candidate who has not attended any school but studied at home is also eligible to apply for admission in Class VI (As per section 4 of Chapter II of RTE Act 2009). However, the parents/ guardian of the candidate shall have to submit a self-declaration regarding the same. Actual admission in Class-VI for the session **2022-23** will be based on the merit of the Selection Test provided above mentioned conditions are fulfilled by the candidates.

## 2.2. Class Strength and Competent Authorities:

### 2.2.1 EMRS

A fully functional EMRS shall have 2 sections in each class from VI to X and 3 sections in Class XI & XII (one of each stream viz. Science, Commerce & Humanities) with a total sanctioned strength of 480.

Note: - Since EMRS schools are into co-ed education the number of seats for boys and girls will be equal.

### 2.2.2 KSP

A fully functional KSP shall have 2 sections in each class from VI to X and 3 sections in Class XI & XII (one of each stream viz. Science, Commerce & Humanities) with a total sanctioned strength of 490.

### 2.2.3 MRS

A fully functional MRS shall have 1 section in each class from VI to X and 3 sections in Class XI & XII (one of each stream viz. Science, Commerce & Humanities) with a total sanctioned strength of 245.

Note: - The MRS currently running as only boys schools shall have to go for smooth progressive transition into co-educational schools, so as a PILOT all the remaining vacant seats from 7<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> class may be filled by day scholar girls students.

In long term the schools are advised to do the necessary changes/arrangement required for residential and other requirements for the girl's students.

The below mentioned reservation criteria shall be followed for granting admissions in Class VI of EMRS, KSP and MRS: -

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**Note:** The Children of Staff of EMRS, KSP & MRS should be given admission over and above the prescribed strength of students per section per Class. This facility shall be extended to only eldest two surviving children of Staff of EMRS, KSP & MRS.

The Principal is authorized to admit the children of staff in the respective EMRS, KSP & MRS where the parent is working.

**Further, no additional financial implications are to be borne by MPSARAS/ NESTS/ MoTA as these children shall not be a part of EMRS, KSP & MRS Scheme. Since, no fee is prescribed in EMRS, KSP & MRS Scheme hence; the same shall not be charged from these students.**

- II. The number of seats for boys and girls will be equal. However, the EMRS which are running as only Boys or Girls schools shall have to go for smooth progressive transition into co-educational schools starting with class VI from academic year 22-23.
- III. 3% of total available seats for admission will be horizontally reserved for Differently Abled-children as per the provisions of RTE Act, 2009 and the same has been mentioned in table 2.3.
- IV. Transgender category students shall not be denied admission subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions.
- V. For point no. 3, the proposed consolidated quota of reservation is 10%.
- VI. If a child belongs to more than one reservation category then he/ she shall be allowed to avail the benefit of only one reservation category with the highest reservation percentage.
- VII. The merit list for each category shall be prepared separately on the basis of the Selection Test. The cut off marks shall be different for different reservation categories children of Staff of EMRS, KSP & MRS shall be granted admission directly in class VI.

**It is clarified that the children of Staff of EMRS, KSP & MRS shall not be a part of EMRS, KSP & MRS Scheme and no financial implications in respect of these children shall be borne out of the fund released by MPSARAS/NESTS/ MoTA.**

### **PART-3 ADMISSION SELECTION PROCEDURE**

Admission to EMRS, KSP & MRS shall be done on the basis of Selection Test. Admission to class VI shall be made strictly on the basis of an entrance test called Madhya Pradesh Special & Residential Schools Selection Test (MPSRSST). The candidates desirous to get admission in EMRS, KSP & MRS have to appear and qualify MPSRSST.

#### **3.1 Admission announcement**

MPSARAS shall notify students about admission to the new session through wide publicity by means of Doordarshan/ All India Radio/ MPTAASC web portal, EMRS, KSP & MRS websites, local newspapers, pamphlets, school notice board etc.

#### **3.2 Procedure to register for MPSRSST 2022-23**

- (i) The candidates belonging to the reservation categories mentioned at reservation table 2.3 are eligible to apply for MPSRSST.
- (ii) Registration forms can be filled through the online mode.
- (iii) For online registration, MPSARAS will provide registration form available at MPTAASC portal. Special measures to be taken to ensure the maximum registration of eligible students.
- (iv) The list of Exam centers for MPSRSST also to be displayed at the designated web-portal and the websites.
- (v) In all EMRS, KSP & MRS a help desk will be available to assist the candidates/parents to fill online form free of cost.

- (vi) Verification of proofs for residence, age, eligibility etc. will be done for selected candidates by the EMRS, KSP & MRS where the child shall be admitted after the declaration of results & provisional list of selected candidates by MPSARAS.

### **3.3. Issue of Admit Cards**

The admit cards will be made available as per schedule decided by MPSARAS which will be displayed on MPTAASC portal. Registered students can download the admit card through MPTAASC portal by providing their DOB and Application number, while EMRS, KSP & MRS which are also exam centers be given the list of students appearing for MPSRSST in their school. As far as possible, the Exam center nearest to the residence of the candidate will be allotted.

### **3.4. Result of the MPSRSST**

The result of MPSRSST will be announced on MPTAASC portal. The result will also be displayed-

- i. On The website of Tribal Affairs, Madhya Pradesh.
- ii. The Principal, EMRS, KSP & MRS concerned, will also inform the selected candidates through SMS on the registered mobile number followed by contacting the student to complete the admission process before the last date of admission.
- iii. A provisional admission list (and waiting list(s), if required), based on MPSRSST shall be released by MPSARAS. The admission in EMRS, KSP & MRS , however, shall be granted to provisionally selected candidates on production & verification of required documents by the concerned EMRS, KSP & MRS .Candidates are advised to apply for TC/ SLC from parent school only after the verification of documents and confirmation of admission by the respective EMRS, KSP & MRS .
- iv. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Commissioner Tribal Affairs/ Secretary MPSARAS shall be final and binding on the candidates.
- v. The candidates and their parents/guardians may note that the children will be admitted strictly as per the Merit list prepared on the basis of MPSRSST and in the allotted EMRS, KSP & MRS only. Under no circumstances, the selected candidate will

be given admission to any other EMRS, KSP & MRS. No request for shifting of students on account of residence in a particular district, medium of instruction in the EMRS, KSP & MRS concerned, shifting of parents/guardians to other districts / States etc. will be entertained. However, there shall be likelihood (but no guarantee) of admission of a candidate in the block/taluka/tehsil/district of his/her residence as per Merit list of MPSRSST. The candidate has to furnish five preferences for admission in respect of the EMRS, KSP & MRS running in their State. If a candidate, on the basis of the merit list, is eligible for admission in the EMRS, KSP & MRS other than five preferential EMRS, KSP & MRS, then he/ she shall be granted admission in that school in accordance with his/her position in the Merit List.

- vi. Counseling Sessions need to be conducted while allocating seat in the EMRS, KSP & MRS to the student based on his/ her preferences and position in the merit list prepared on the basis of MPSRSST.
- vii. The seats should be open to all ST children of the State with no specific reservation quota for the ST resident of block/ taluka/tehsil/district in which EMRS, KSP & MRS is situated.
- viii. It is clarified that the candidates belonging to the reservation categories as mentioned in the table 2.3 across the State are eligible to apply for admission in any of EMRS, KSP & MRS irrespective of the fact that whether an EMRS, KSP & MRS is running in their block/ taluka/ tehsil/ district of residence or not.
- ix. Incomplete application forms shall normally be rejected. In case vacancies remain Secretary MPSARAS may allow lateral admissions in class VI by allowing schools to organize lateral entry test at school level.
- x. Admission secured on the basis of any wrong certificate shall be cancelled by the Principal forthwith and no appeal against such action of the Principal shall be considered.

## **PART 4 - DOCUMENTATION**

**The candidates who are provisionally selected for admission will have to submit the requisite documents, as demanded by the EMRS, KSP & MRS, at the time of admission for verification. The MPSARAS shall have to inform the candidates at the time of Registration & display of list of provisionally selected Candidates about the documents required for Admission.**

**However, a list of Mandatory documents is mentioned as below: -**

- i. Birth certificate.
- ii. Domicile certificate.
- iii. Reservation Category certificate.
- iv. Service Certificate of the parents in case of Children of Staff of EMRS, KSP & MRS .
- v. Disability Certificate, if applicable.
- vi. Report Card of the preceding class/ an Affidavit in case of the children who have not attended any school but studied at home.
- vii. Medical Checkup of the Provisional Selected Students is to be carried out by the EMRS, KSP & MRS.
- viii. Transfer Certificate/ School Leaving Certificate from the previous School.
- ix. Any other documents required. (As mentioned by MPSARAS)
- x. Beneficiary (Student) Profile ID (MPTAASC) at the time of confirming admission in the allotted school.

## **PART 5 – COMPOSITION OF THE TEST**

The MPSRSST conducted will be of **two-hour duration** with 100 objective type questions from 3 sections for a total of 100 marks. The medium of instruction for the Examination may be English & Hindi (Bilingual)

A single test booklet comprising of all the three sections will be given to each candidate. There shall be no syllabus for MPSRSST. The Question Paper of MPSRSST will be based on Competencies in accordance with the Level prescribed for Class V students by NCERT/ SCERT/ CBSE.

Additional time of 30 minutes will be allowed for “Divyang students” who are blind or whose writing speed is affected due to their disability

The Blind candidates are allowed to take help of scribe (Reader/Writer) in the MPSRSST, the scribe should be one grade junior to the candidate. If the blind candidate has difficulty to bring his own scribe it will be the responsibility of exam centre superintendent to provide the help of a scribe who must have the proper ability of reading and writing in the exam.



## **5.1. Method of Recording Answers**

- MPSARAS will provide a separate OMR (Optical Mark Recognition) answer sheet at the allotted exam centre's where the candidates are required to indicate their answers in designated exam time.
- The Blind candidates are allowed to take help of scribe (Reader/Writer) in the MPSRSST; the scribe should be one grade junior to the candidate. If the blind candidate has difficulty to bring his own scribe it will be the responsibility of exam centre superintendent to provide the help of a scribe who must have the proper ability of reading and writing in the exam.
- The record of MPSRSST, post declaration of MPSRSST result, shall have to be preserved for six months. And in case of legal implications, the record of MPSRSST shall be preserved for one year further after the disposal of litigation. Litigations regarding conduct of MPSRSST shall be dealt by MPSARAS.
- In unprecedented circumstances like Covid-19 pandemic, the Secretary MPSARAS may adopt other methods for drawing the Merit List for admission in EMRS, KSP & MRS.

## **PART 6 – LATERAL ENTRY IN EMRS, KSP & MRS**

### **6.1 Admission for Class VII – IX and XI**

Lateral entry in EMRS, KSP & MRS in the classes VII – IX & XI will be allowed subject to availability of vacancies. The general eligibility conditions for the same shall be:

- Candidates should be of age group as prescribed at 2.1 (Applicable to all the categories).
- Candidates should have studied VI/VII/VIII/X class for admission to class VII/VIII/IX/XI respectively from a Govt. / Govt. aided/ Govt. recognized School/ CBSE Affiliated School/ Level C of NIOS OBE Programme (for admission in Class IX). Or a Candidate who has not attended any school but studied at home is also eligible to apply for admission in Class VII & VIII (As per section 4 of Chapter II of RTE Act 2009). However, the parents/ guardian of the candidate shall have to submit a self-declaration regarding the same.
- Candidate should not be rusticated from any of the Schools.

### **6.2 Admission for Class X and XII**

Admissions to class X & XII will be entertained by the Principal of EMRS, KSP & MRS subject to availability of vacancies. Such admissions to class X and XII will be considered only if, the average strength in class IX & X and XI & XII taken together is less than 60 per class for EMRS, 70 per class for KSP and 35 per class for MRS.

This will further be subject to the following conditions:

- The child has been in the same course of studies i.e. in a CBSE-affiliated school for CBSE Affiliated EMRS, KSP & MRS and in a State Board School for State Board Affiliated EMRS, KSP & MRS.
- For Class X, the child must have obtained not less than 50% marks in aggregate in class IX.
- For admission to class XII, 50% marks in class XI examination is mandatory.
- The child should otherwise be eligible as per EMRS, KSP & MRS admission guidelines.
- The combinations of subjects opted by the student are available in EMRS, KSP & MRS.

### **6.3 Procedure of Admission for Class VII – IX**

Admission to Class VII – IX in EMRS, KSP & MRS shall be done on the basis of an entrance test called MPSRSLT (Madhya Pradesh Special & Residential School Lateral Entry Test). The candidates desirous to get admission in class VII – IX in EMRS, KSP & MRS shall have to appear and qualify the MPSRSLT Depending upon the availability of vacancies, EMRS, KSP & MRS will conduct MPSRSLT for the classes VII – IX in respect of the candidates' seeking admission in their school.

#### **Composition of MPSRSLT for Class VII – IX**

The entrance test (MPSRSLT), conducted in offline mode only, may be a pen-paper test of three hours duration with both objective & descriptive type questions from 5 sections. The questions for MPSRSLT shall be asked from NCERT/ SCERT textbooks of preceding viz. Class VI-VIII in case of CBSE / State Board affiliated EMRS, KSP & MRS s respectively. There shall be total of 100 questions for 200 marks. The medium of instruction for the Examination is English & Hindi (Bilingual)

Additional time of 30 minutes will be allowed for “Divyang students” who are blind or whose writing speed is affected due to their disability.

The Blind candidates are allowed to take help of scribe (Reader/Writer) in the MPSRSLT; the scribe should be one grade junior to the candidate. If the blind candidate has difficulty to bring his own scribe it will be the responsibility of Principal to provide the help of a scribe who must have the proper ability of reading and writing in the exam.

Other modalities of MPSRSLT shall be same as that of MPSRSST.

#### **6.4 Procedure of Admission for Class XI**

No entrance test shall be conducted by EMRS, KSP & MRS for admission in class XI. The candidates are selected on the basis of marks/ CGPA obtained by them in class X in CBSE / State Board.

##### **EMRS, KSP & MRS Students:**

The students declared Passed in Class X by the CBSE/ State Board shall be automatically granted admission to class XI in the same EMRS, KSP & MRS. However, offer of stream viz. Science, Commerce; Humanities will be strictly on merit.

The Merit List may be prepared on the following criteria:

- **Science Stream with Mathematics:** Aggregate marks scored in class X + marks scored in Science + marks scored in Mathematics.
- **Science Stream without Mathematics:** Aggregate marks scored in class X + marks scored in Science.
- **Commerce Stream with Mathematics:** Aggregate marks scored in class X + marks scored in Social Science + marks scored in Mathematics.

- **Commerce Stream without Mathematics:** Aggregate marks scored in class X + marks scored in Social Science.
- **Humanities Stream:** All students declared passed in Class X by CBSE/ State Board.

**Note:-**

- If seats remain vacant in class XI even after admitting the children of EMRS, KSP & MRS, then the admissions to non-EMRS, KSP & MRS children belonging to the reservation categories mentioned in reservation table at 2.3 may be granted on the same criteria.
- Student who was earlier not found eligible for admission to a particular stream may be allowed fresh admission to a particular stream in class XI in the next academic session, if he/she improves his/her performance within one year from the same Board.

## **6.5 Students of State Boards/ ICSE/ NIOS for Admission in Class XI in EMRS, KSP & MRS**

The students of State Boards/ ICSE/ NIOS may be considered for admission in class XI if vacancies exist.

## **6.6 Special provisions**

- Children of Staff of EMRS, KSP & MRS should be given admission over and above the prescribed strength of students per section per Class.

- This facility shall be extended to only eldest two surviving children of Staff of EMRS, KSP & MRS.
- It is clarified that the children of Staff of EMRS, KSP & MRS shall not be a part of EMRS, KSP & MRS Scheme and no financial implications in respect of these children shall be borne out of the fund released by MPSARAS/NESTS/MoTA.
- In case of insufficient registration/ non-registration/ insufficient selection in (MPSRSST) or MPSRSLT/ insufficient turn out for admissions, the seats reserved for a particular reservation category shall be de-reserved into other reservation categories as mentioned below:
